HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE: Resources are divided into sections based on the severity of the concern. For example, parenting groups and breastfeeding support can be helpful and sufficient for some mild to moderately depressed caregivers. Use the EPDS (Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Scale) and PHQ-9 (Patient Health Questionnaire-9) score suggestions to help choose a resource. Please note that most physical resources are located in Nassau County unless otherwise specified.
